This is truly a "new-event-that-will-be-heard-'round-the-world". Although I am a physician, many kinds of music have been my passion for as long as I can remember. I've studied piano with two teachers (years apart), organ with three teachers (also years apart), and trumpet with three teachers during high school and college. I've been a semi-professional pianist and organist for about 40 years. The Philadelphia Orchestra has been a listening passion since long before I moved to Philadelphia.
